

**Clinical Supervisor/Therapist (LMFT/LCSW)**

Clinician Supervisor will provide individual and/or group supervision to trainees and interns in Parent Resources Department. Supervisor may carry a client caseload, separate from supervisory duties.

Essential functions include providing weekly individual and/or group supervision and consultation to supervisees. Provide additional support to supervisees as needed in crisis situations or when urgent issues arise. Review supervisees' documentation on a regular basis, including reading and providing feedback regarding assessments, progress notes and other documentation.

Essential competencies are in accordance with BBS regulations. Clinical Supervisors must be licensed for a minimum of 2 years prior to commencing supervision. Supervisors must also complete a minimum of 6 units of an approved supervisor course every two years. Those who supervise ASW interns must complete a minimum of 15 units of an approved supervision course every two years (psychologist are exempt from this requirement).
