Under the direction and supervision of the Special Education Principal, provides students who are severely emotionally disturbed an instructional program based on student time on task and encompassing mastery learning theory.

#### **Employment Standards:**

- Broad background, extensive knowledge and practical application of principals, practices, methods and strategies applicable to students with serious emotional disturbances or severe handicaps.
- Strong assessment skills appropriate for severely handicapped individuals.
- Demonstrates ability to organize, prioritize, and deliver a variety of instructional strategies.
- Expresses ideas and concepts clearly and concisely in both oral and written form.
- Demonstrates ability to establish and maintain cooperative working relationships with students, teachers, staff, and parents.
- Ability to work with acting out and disturbed students, in a highly structured behavioral program.
- Knowledge of interagency relationships and effective methods of program coordination.
- knowledge of laws, codes, and regulations as they relate to special education.
- Personal qualities of leadership, integrity, fairness, optimism, self-confidence, persistence, and vitality.

#### **Typical Duties:**

- Develop goals and objectives for multi-graded classes and variety of handicap conditions.
- Implement Individual Education Programs (IEP) for all students.
- Provide direct instruction and services to students.
- Monitor student progress as it relates to established IEP's.
- Work as a member of a trans-disciplinary team for planning and implementing data based instructional programs.
- Develop transition plans to move students to targeted integrated or community based activities, and/or transition to adult lifestyles.
